POLICY FOR DEALING WITH POST AND EMAILS

POST

All post received by the Parish Clerk is brought to the Parish Council meeting.

Councillors review all the post received.

It is not within the remit of the Chairman or Clerk to reply to general correspondence before it has been tabled at a Parish Council meeting.

The Clerk will take instructions from members and reply to correspondence requiring an answer during the month following the meeting.

If the Parish Council are not due to meet within one month an acknowledgement will be sent to the correspondent.

EMAILS

All emails are forwarded to all members of the Parish Council with access to email.

All councillors are asked to check their emails regularly and inform the Clerk or Chairman of anything that they wish to be tabled at the next Parish Council meeting.

All councillors review all emails received and bring anything they feel to be of relevance or importance to Brenzett to the attention of councillors at the Parish Council Meeting.

It is not within the remit of the Chairman or Clerk to reply to general emails before they have been tabled at a Parish Council meeting.

The Clerk will take instructions from members and reply to emails requiring an answer during the month following the meeting.

If the Parish Council are not due to meet within one month an acknowledgement will be sent to the correspondent.
